The E-Class Cabriolet completes the line-up of E-Class vehicles in breathtaking style. Thanks to innovative features such as Aircap and Airscarf, the Cabriolet delivers a superb top-down driving experience yet also offers genuine fleet credentials.

All 4 and 6 cylinder engines are BlueEFFICIENCY optimised, providing powerful yet frugal performance, ideal for business use. Duty of care is high on the agenda too, with extensive safety features ranging from Attention Assist to Adaptive High Beam Assist and Active Bonnet all as standard.



BlueEFFICIENCY

Making a difference

As with all Mercedes-Benz vehicles, the E-Class Cabriolet has been designed and engineered to minimise its environmental impact. The majority of models are BlueEFFICIENCY optimised and it's the first ever Mercedes-Benz Cabriolet to offer diesel engines.

These include two 4-cylinder units, the E 220 CDI and E 250 CDI, which use twin turbochargers to deliver impressive power. Yet they also offer superb efficiency, with fuel economy of up to 52.3 mpg combined and CO₂ emissions from only 143 g/km. Benefit in Kind is just 20% or 21% respectively with a write down allowance of 20%.

To complete the line-up, there's a choice of powerful yet frugal V6 petrol and diesel engines all with BlueEFFICIENCY technology, plus the V8 E 500.



Innovations

Smart thinking

Advanced technology is a hallmark of all E-Class vehicles and the Cabriolet is no exception. Standard features include the Aircap wind deflector, which directs air flow up and over the cabin when the top is down. This helps reduce turbulence and noise, making for a more pleasurable open-top experience.

The optional Airscarf (image above) further enhances comfort by channelling warm air around the head and neck area of the driver and front seat passenger.

Safety is another key area of innovation with Attention Assist fitted as standard to monitor driver's behaviour to detect fatigue – a serious risk on long business journeys. Other key systems include Adaptive High Beam Assist (standard on the Sport), front and rear Parktronic with Advanced Parking Guidance.



Duty of care

Safety without compromise

Fleet managers can rest assured - the E-Class Cabriolet offers exemplary safety levels, even with the top down. Rollover protection includes reinforced A-pillars and special rollover bars housed in the rear head restraints. Should the Cabriolet's tilt sensor detect signs of a potential accident, the rollover bars are automatically triggered, locking into place in milliseconds.

The Pre-Safe® anticipatory safety system is also fitted as standard, along with Flashing Adaptive Brake lights that significantly reduce the risks of rear-end collisions. An array of airbags include pelvisbags in front seats, featured for the first time on a Mercedes-Benz Cabriolet.

For enhanced night safety, the optional Intelligent Light System, including the Active Light System and Adaptive High Beam Assist comes as standard on the Sport model and is optional on the SE model.



Comfort and Driving Dynamic

A refined open-top experience

As you'd expect from a member of the E-Class family, the Cabriolet delivers an impeccable driving experience. Agility Control suspension with Selective Damping System comes as standard, continuously adjusting shock absorption to suit the road surface. The resulting ride is blissfully smooth, yet handling remains responsive and rewarding.

The Aircap wind deflector system is another standard feature, channelling air turbulence away from the cabin when the roof is down. As a result, occupants will enjoy a quieter, more relaxing open-top motoring experience.

For long journey comfort, the Cabriolet also comes with heated front seats, automatic climate control and automatic belt feeder as standard. Options include a range of navigation systems and the Airscarf heating system.



Design

Classic meets contemporary

The E-Class Cabriolet blends traditional open-top style with modern day comfort and performance. The roof, for example, is a classic fabric soft-top available in three colours, yet it incorporates the latest technology to ensure optimum thermal and acoustic insulation.

Exterior design elements include a bold radiator grille with three-pointed star, flanked by distinctive twin headlamps. Dynamic contour lines, muscular haunches and LED tail lights heighten the car's dramatic looks.

Inside the car, business users will find the combination of sumptuous materials and contemporary styling irresistible. Naturally, the entire cabin boasts superb ergonomics and exceptional comfort, whether the roof is up or down.



Model lines

Extensive equipment and distinctive style

The E-Class Cabriolet is available in both SE and Sport model lines.

The SE has a refined, sophisticated look and feel, with 17" alloy wheels, leather upholstery and brushed aluminium trim as standard. Also included are heated front seats and front and rear Parktronic with Advanced Parking Guidance, which helps reduce the risk of costly bumps and scrapes.

On the Sport model, AMG bodystyling, front and rear aprons and side skirts, 18" AMG alloy wheels and sports suspension emphasise the Cabriolet's superb performance. Inside, there are AMG styling elements and Multi-contour seats with Artico artificial leather upholstery.

Standard equipment on the Sport includes the Intelligent Light System with bi-xenon headlamps and LED daytime running lights and Adaptive High Beam Assist – a real asset on A-roads and B-roads at night.
